

IMPULSE Iran-Austria

IMPULSE Iran - Austria is based on a mutual interest to considerably improve knowledge exchange on an international level and to strengthen the international profile of the institutions involved. The aim of the programme is to stimulate joint activities and contribute to direct collaboration among universities, higher education and research institutions of both countries. Thus, the MSRT and the OeAD-GmbH will support the initiating phase of sustainable partnerships financially with means from their respective funds.

The Centre for International Scientific Cooperation of the Ministry of Science, Research & Technology will be in charge of the administration of all relevant programme procedures on the Iranian side, and Mobility at the OeAD-GmbH will be in charge of administering all relevant programme procedures on the Austrian side.

Deputy Minister Prof. H. Salar Amoli, Ministry of Science, Research and Technology of the Islamic Republic of Iran and Director General Dr. Stefan Zotti, Austrian Agency for International Cooperation in Science and Research, present their compliments to the ministers and are honoured to inform about the state of play of the Economic Relations Road Map's implementation concerning the negotiations of a scholarship programme (see Road Map p. 34).

In July 2016 <u>Dr.</u> S. Zotti visited Tehran to discuss the scholarship programme on the basis of the Road Map. Based on the current number of cooperating institutions, the parties agreed in their analysis that such an agreement would be difficult to implement at the moment. Both sides share the opinion that it seems necessary to first enhance the bilateral relations between Iranian and Austrian Higher Education Institutions to make a scholarship agreement work at a later stage. Therefore both sides propose creating an instrument to finance the setup of institutional strategic partnerships.

To further facilitate successful bilateral cooperation in fields of mutual interest the working group was enlarged and modified on both sides.

Acting Minister, Prof. H. Salar Amoli and Director General, Dr. S. Zotti are honoured to propose to the ministers the creation of the 'IMPULSE Iran Programme' aiming at supporting the setup of strategic partnerships between Iranian and Austrian HEIs with up to € 400.000, financed by both sides in equal shares. A proposal of the respective agreement is enclosed.

The signatories ask the ministers to take note and mandate them to sign the agreement in the course of the First Iranian-Austrian Science Conference from $14^{\rm th}$ to $15^{\rm th}$ of January 2017 in Tehran, I. R. of Iran.

Austrian Agency for International Cooperation in Science and Research (OeAD-GmbH)

Eligibility:

Austrian and Iranian Higher Education Institutions — State Universities, Private Universities, Universities of Applied Sciences, University Colleges of Teacher Education and Research Institutions.

Funding Regulations:

The MSRT will cover the ones on the Iranian side and the OeAD-GmbH will cover the costs which arise on the Austrian side.

- •Max. 70% of the overall project costs, up to 30,000 EURO per partnership financed by both countries.
- •10% of the overall programme funding is allocated on projects dealing with issues of teacher education.
- Project duration of one year: maximum 20,000 EURO.
- Project duration of two years: maximum 30.000 EURO.
- •Eligible cost categories are labour costs, travel & subsistence and other costs.

Further Information for Applicants:

For each partnership a project coordinator has to be nominated in Iran and Austria. These coordinators will be responsible for the submission of the proposals.

The partnerships must be in line with the academic focus of the institutions internationalisation strategy. Thus a Letter of Intent from the leading management (e.g. rectorate) of all partner institutions has to be included in the proposal.


Key Dates:


The call for applications is open until September 30th, 2017.
